

Making the most of your Harnessing Technology Grant

Have you heard of the Harnessing Technology Grant (HTG)? Have you had yours yet?

What is the HTG and what is it for?

The Harnessing Technology Grant (HTG) replaces the national digital infrastructure grant and eLCs and as such can be used to purchase the products and services for which you used these grants in the past. Other monies available for technology include the School Development Grant and Devolved Formula Capital.

The HTG has been put in place to help you deliver the **Harnessing Technology Strategy** first introduced by the DCSF in 2005 and revised by BECTA this year. The main intended outcomes from this strategy are:

- **technology-confident effective providers**—we help by providing blended resources and training to help you embed ICT effectively and meaningfully into your teaching.
- **engaged and empowered learners**—we support this aim by providing motivating multimedia software and home licences to extend use outside the school day
- **confident system leadership and innovation**—we provide a rounded service to help you get the most from your investment to transform teaching and learning
- **enabling infrastructure and processes**—scorm packages can be downloaded for all Kar2ouche titles to facilitate integration with your VLE.
- **improved personalised learning experiences**—our flexible tools enable you to create and share exciting multimedia resources to suit the needs of your students.

Have you got your HTG yet?

The funding is distributed to schools via local authorities, through the Standards Fund. Local authorities are able to retain up to 25% (possibly more with the explicit agreement of their Schools Forum) for central procurement deals. From our experience authorities are handling the devolvement of monies in many different ways (including requiring schools to bid) so, if you are unsure whether or not you have received your allocation you need to contact your local authority finance officer.
